VI. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

I will cooperate with the electrical inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.

VII. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear the architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area.
2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

VIII. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

When installing wiring for a new single-family home at a minimum the permit application must include the application fee, permanent service, rough and final inspection. When installing wiring for new modular home at a minimum the application must include the application fee, permanent service and final inspection.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.**
 When ready for an inspection, call Western Washtenaw Construction Authority at (734) 428-7001 providing as much advance notice as possible. The office will need the **requestor's name, phone number, job location and permit number.**

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION.**
