1) Lawrence Cameron Land Split. Planner Nanney went over his report. The survey corrections were made promptly. The application and updated survey dated 7-3-2023 are complete and ready for Planning Commission consideration and action. Flahie with support of Bossory made a motion to approve the division of the 79.88 acre parcel N14-15-100-003 into a proposed 10.0 acre Parcel A and a 69.88 acre remainder Parcel B as depicted on the updated Piatt Land Surveying LLC survey (job number 2021-1355) dated July 3, 2023. A roll call vote was taken. Bossory-yes, Flahie-yes, Little-yes and Ochs-yes. The motion passed.

Old Business:

- 1) Review of Lake District Article 3.0 and Ordinance 43-B. A Public Hearing has been set for the September 5, 2023 meeting.
